Privacy Policy for the use of www.padigest.ro

What kind of information we collect from you?

Public Affairs Digest (<u>www.padigest.ro</u>) collects information about the user (1) directly from the user through the account information provided by the user, (2) from the hosting server traffic reports and (3) from the use of cookies.

1. Information provided directly by the user

When you subscribe to Public Affairs Digest, you will provide your name, e-mail address, telephone number, company and position. We use this information in order to identify you and provide you with the services that you select through your personal account.

2. Information from the server traffic report

When you visit a website, you disclose certain information about yourself such as your IP address, time of your visit, the place where you entered our sites. Public Affairs Digest, like most websites, records this information. This type of information helps us identify which parts of the website is of more interest to users.

3. Cookies

Since the access to the webpages of Public Affairs Digest is conditional upon the user being logged in, the website uses cookies in order to know if and when a user account is logged in or not, and also for storing the login data (username and password) if the user so chooses. Cookies may also be used in order to observe the preferences linked to your account, as well as for traffic analysis.

Cookies are provided to your browser by our webserver and then stored on your device. Most browsers are set by default to accept cookies, but if you prefer it, you can set your browser either to notify you whenever you receive a cookie or to reject the incoming cookies.

Public Affairs Digest does not provide any third-party services to its users, therefore except for the cookies necessary for the traffic reports, there will be no third-party cookies stored on your device.

How we protect the information collected from you

The confidentiality of the information collected from or related to you is very important to us. Public Affairs Digest does not transfer this information to third parties without your prior express consent.

However, Public Affairs Digestmay disclose personal data of the users when the law requires it or when this is necessary in order to protect the rights and interests of Public Affairs Digest.
